Distance between Tonga and Kwiek measures 285 miles long on the west bank of the Nile.

Distance on Sobat bank from Dolibhill to Nagdiar is 10 miles long .

Total length of Occupied Shilluk land is 295 miles.

In shot  $295 \div 41 = 7$  miles. This clearly indicates that military Barracks are situated every 7 miles along the Shilluk land.
