#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

---

Under the general supervision of the FAO Head of Office in South Sudan and under the direct supervision of the Technical Officer (Food Security Analysis), and in coordination with the relevant FAO headquarters Lead Technical Unit (LTU), the incumbent will provide support in the implementation of the programme. In particular, the incumbent will:

- Assist in providing technical support to the Food Security Technical Secretariat and other targeted ministries (both at national and State level) on food security analysis;
- Assist in supporting the Food Security Technical Secretariat to maintain and expand the network of stakeholders related to food, agriculture, natural resources, humanitarian assistance;
- Assist the States FS institutional set-up to ensure data collection and analysis for food security analysis;
- Assist in design and implementation of training and other capacity building activities for the use of IPC tool in food security situation analysis;
- Assist in coordinating all Food Security analysis related activities with other donors and international agencies dealing in Food Security analysis issues;
- Participate in the food security and livelihood cluster meetings and making presentations of the food security situation including the IPC
- Coordinate all livelihood analysis forums and assist in generating the IPC maps while working with the food security and livelihood cluster
- Assist the ministry of agriculture, forestry, cooperatives and rural development and the ministry of animal resources and fisheries in producing food security bulletins
- Contribute to regular updates to the CTA and relevant programme team members on progress, priorities and constraints, verbally and in writing on an agreed frequency and assure the preparation of required reports as per the rules and regulations of FAO;
- Perform other duties as required

#### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

*Candidates should meet the following:*

- Advanced university degree in Food Security, Agricultural Economics, or in a related technical discipline
- Three years of relevant experience in food security information and analysis
- Working knowledge of English

- Demonstrated ability to liaise with multiple UN, NGO, governmental, and media agencies

- Extent of relevant work experience in South Sudan
- Excellent communication, writing and presentation skills in English
